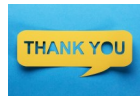

KADESH CORNER

We thought we would do a quick “Frequently Asked Questions” for Camp Kadesh in this season.

What does spring look like a Camp Kadesh? We’re really excited that between May 24th and June 24th we will have over 1500 students and their teachers come to Camp Kadesh. We currently have a staff of 20 spring program staff, 3 kitchen staff and our 4 full time staff working to serve these school. Our spring school program represents an excellent chance to reach out into the community and introduce them to Camp Kadesh. Many of the students that come to spring end up coming back for summer camp, and then have an opportunity to hear the Gospel in full. **Please pray for our staff this spring as we serve schools.**

How are numbers for summer camps? We weren’t sure what was going to happen post covid with summer camps. We are beginning to see registrations come in and we planned for a summer with camper registration at about 800. This week we surpassed the 700 camper mark and it seems that interest is growing as spring has arrived. We also know that we will see students that come to our spring program sign up for camp. **Please pray that we would be able to fill the spots that we have available.**

Why are numbers low this year? It seems to be a lot of reason. Some families are still concerned about the safety of camps with Covid still around. In some cases it is a loss of momentum. We haven’t run camps at full capacity since 2019 and we lost two years of campers experiencing camp and the excitement it brings, some people found other things to do in summer and camp isn’t a priority this year. Some people are just waiting to sign up because after two years of things getting cancelled they are hesitant to sign kids up only to be disappointed. **Please pray that the right kids would find their way to camp this summer.**

On a separate note, thank you to the group from Sutherland Evangelical Church that came out to do some outdoor work and small construction projects last weekend. We always have lots of jobs that can be done if there are willing people. If an individual or group would like to come to camp and help us with tasks please reach out to our office for more information. We don’t always post the jobs that need doing, but there is always lots of simple brush work around our cabins, small projects that need building, trees that need cutting and logs that need splitting. We’ll find projects for those that are willing.
