Hello Churches,

As we finish our third week and enter our fourth we are excited for what God is doing. This week is our second week of Junior Teen (ages 12 - 14). This week we have Jon Ravichander as our speaker. Jon is the Youth Pastor at Circle Drive Alliance in Saskatoon a church that we have seen more and more Saskatoon based campers getting connected to. We are excited for all the campers that are in this age group but especially those that are coming for the very first time.

As we approach the midpoint of summer it's a good time to look at some statistics so far. Our goal was to get to 800 campers which this week we surpassed. We still have room in camps, so we are now reaching for a possible 850 campers. While these numbers feel a little disappointing compared to the over 1100 campers we had in 2019 - we trust that God is helping us rebuild after two years of uncertainty. It's interesting that 65% of our campers are coming for the very first time. **Please pray that we would continue to fill as many beds with campers as possible as we move into August.**

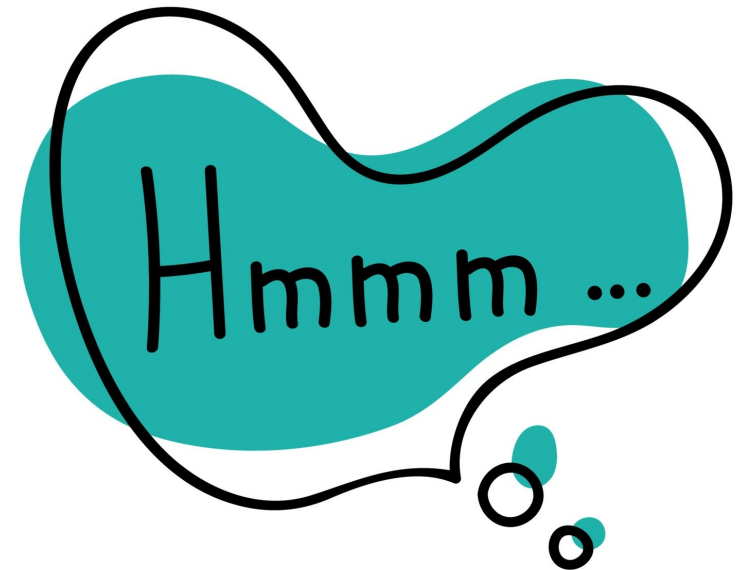
