CAMP KADESH UPDATE Hello Churches

As registration has been open for a month already we are starting to see the effects of Covid on some families. We are seeing a higher number of families applying for additional subsidy. We see families that have lost jobs in the last two year or other financial issues that make sending their kids to camp difficult with out substantial subsidy. This year we have already subsidized almost \$10,000 of camp fees to ensure that every child gets a chance at camp. These amounts are in addition to our automatic subsidy available to all campers.

We know that people love to support these types of programs. Here are a few ways you can support subsidizing campers that need financial assistance:

Sarcan Recycling. If you use Sarcan's "Drop and Go" program you can drop of your recyclable drink containers and use the code "CAMP KADESH" to directly donate the money to Kadesh. Find out more at www.campkadesh.com/recycle

Donate online: A donation online supports these subsidies and helps us know how much money we can provide.

Ultimately we want to work to see as many children come to camp this summer as possible. If you know a family that would love to have their children come to camp, but they lack the funds, the application for subsidy is available on our website www.campkadesh.com/subsidy

Please pray for our team as we work to process all the request for subsidy and get kids into camp. The majority of our campers are children that do not regularly attend church and often hear the gospel for the first time at camp. Our mission is to introduce these campers to Jesus through the opportunity that summer camp provides.


