CAMP KADESH UPDATE

Hello Church

Even though there has been snow this week, our spring and summer programs are coming fast. In one month we start our Spring School programs.

We are looking for a few individuals that might be willing to do some small and medium building projects. These projects are fairly simple projects like building box games for students or campers and building some boxes with shelves for the cabins. They are not complex, but do take time. Some of these could be done at Kadesh or in a person's own workshop depending on preference. We are still looking to fill many positions for Junior Cabin Leaders (JCs). While we have a great roster of Senior Cabin leaders (typically College age staff) we are really missing JC applicants. These junior staff are typically grade 11 or 12 students that are passionate about seeing kids hear the gospel, but might lack the experience of leading a full cabin on their own. JCs are paired with a Sr Cabin leader to lead a cabin of 8 - 11 campers per week. Typically Junior Cabin leaders are at camp for 1 to 3 weeks in the summer and we would welcome young people that don't have a lot of experience with Kadesh, but would love the experience to consider coming to camp. **Please pray that we fill these key development roles for summer.**

We are excited that we have a very full enrolment for our Leader in Training Program (LIT). Many people are not aware we have a one week volunteer experience for anyone who is 13 years of age or older as a first opportunity to be a part of the staff team. Work Crew takes on the various food service and janitorial responsibilities to be completed throughout the day during our Kids Week. This particular position is designed to be 2 parts work, 1 part fun. We work during the day and build community doing fun things in the evenings. This year it is July 3 - 8 and more information can be found on our website under "volunteer opportunities". **Please pray for all of our young staff that are considering being at camp this summer.**
