KADESH CORNER

Hello Churches, This week was the first week of our Spring School Programs. We had the first 4 school groups of what will be over 1500 students this spring. We are really excited to have these students on site for one, two and three day programs. Spring is a great entry point into summer and we know that many campers sign up because of a trip to Kadesh in Spring. **Please pray that we would have influence on these students and some would come back for summer camp.**

We continue to deal with Covid at camp. We have protocols when someone tests positive, but it often means losing that staff member for the week. **We are really asking for supporters to pray for health this spring and summer. Not only for protection from getting sick, but for the increased work load and stress as we have to adjust schedules for everyone on staff.**

Enrolment for summer is still slow but we are seeing increased interest and enrolment as spring arrives and families start thinking about summer. We do have some camps that are sold out, but are working to hire more staff to fill spots off of waitlists. Our limits currently are staffing limits and not cabin capacity. Key needs for summer are still primarily high school aged male and female staff to work beside our older cabin staff. Praise to God we found a boat driver for all of summer. **Please pray that we would continue to fill these needed roles and see new campers sign up.**
